Hello Everyone - We finally have all of the revised Santa Clara/Forum Festival Information. ***The total price of the trip will be \$240.00 per student.*** If you have already paid the deposit of \$100.00 the balance of \$140.00 will be due and payable on April 15<sup>th</sup> (if you have not paid a deposit, please make payment in full by 4/15/10). If your student Fair share account has a credit that you would like to apply toward the cost of the trip, please contact Christy Coats and she will check the account balance and provide Paul with the list of students who will be paying in this manner. You must request this action, please do not assume that your credit balance will automatically be used in this way.

The students will be leaving LAHS at 1:30 on Friday, 5/21/10 and will arrive at the hotel at approximately 9:30 p.m. The buses will be stopping along the way for a quick dinner (most likely a retail strip center with a fast food variety), so please provide money for your student to purchase dinner for this night.

On Saturday, 5/22/10, the students will enjoy a full breakfast at the hotel, and then head to Ohlone College, (43600 Mission Boulevard, Fremont, CA 94539-5847) for the festival. Following the awards ceremony, they will load the bus for transport to California's Great America. Included in their entry is a 2-meal deal voucher for lunch and dinner at the park. You may want to provide your student with a little spending money for miscellaneous items like drinks and souvenirs.

On Sunday, 5/23/10, the students will have an early breakfast (7:00 to 8:30), pack, and load the buses at 9:00 a.m. for return to LAHS. It is anticipated they will arrive at LAHS between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. They will stop for lunch on the way home - please provide money for lunch on this day.

So, quick breakdown:

-- Total Cost \$240 to LAHS Band Boosters (which includes hotel, travel, breakfast on Saturday and Sunday, entry to California's Great America, lunch and dinner at the park).

-- Please provide money for dinner Friday evening, and lunch Sunday, as well as any extra money you wish to send with your child for incidentals and fun money at the park.

-- ***Final payment due Thursday, April 15th.***

Also note our hotel venue changed with the date change. We are now staying at the Fremont Marriott, 46100 Landing Parkway, Fremont, CA 94538.
